A course time is set the day before (which only the huntsman knows) and if you come close to that time, BONUS, you could win a first-sixth place ribbon! (they mail out).

- 1) A release/hold harmless waiver must be completed for every rider by registration. Parents signature is required for juniors, 17 & under, (must ride with an adult). Forms are available at www.metamorahunt.com.
- 2) Protected headgear with chin strap must be worn at all times while mounted. Ride English or Western.
- 3) Your team must confirm with the timekeeper at the start and end in order to be qualified for prizes.
- 4) Please follow the ribbons on the trail as you are riding on private properties. Walk past horses in paddocks and don't cut across hay fields.
- 5) Be courteous of riders if you need to pass. Ask first and wait for a wide spot on trail.
- 6) If you encounter a jump, there is also a walk-around as an option.
